2. If you are going to attend graduate school in philosophy, have you received adequate advising to help you in making decisions about where to attend, how to apply for fellowships etc.?
3. If you are not going to pursue graduate work in philosophy, do you anticipate that your education in our department has prepared you for your career path? (What skills will you need, and have classes in Philosophy helped to provide you with them?)
4. What benefits (other than career goals) has our program provided?
5. Evaluate the quality of the advising you have received in our program. Please let us know in what ways we might improve.
